Indigenous Student Scholarships provide opportunities to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students to attend Southern Cross Grammar at a significant discount. The scholarships are part of the School's plan to help improve education outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students at the secondary schooling level.

Where vacancies occur, up to five scholarships are available to be awarded annually across Years 7-12.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students enrolling in Years 7 to 12 seeking a high performing and academic experience.

HOW TO APPLY

To apply for the Indigenous Scholarship, please complete the scholarship application form and submit the application to the school office by 4:00pm Friday 14 February 2025. Applications must include the candidate's most recent:

- school reports (Semester 1 & 2, 2024)
- NAPLAN results
- Confirmation/Evidence of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent
- Birth Certificate of Applicant
- Documentation in support of student achievements

Scholarships will be awarded on merit against the selection criteria outlined in the guidelines. Priority is given to students who are local, might otherwise be unable to afford this opportunity and have not previously received an Indigenous Scholarship.
