## HOW TO APPLY

To apply for the Music Scholarship, candidates must complete the scholarship application form and submit the application to the school office by 4:00pm on Friday 14 February 2025. Your application must include your most recent:

- school reports (Semester 1 & 2, 2024)
- NAPLAN results
- AMEB or equivalent (e.g. ANZCA, Trinity of London) results and;
- any supporting documentation.

## THE SELECTION PROCESS

- **Audition:** We require Music Scholarship Candidates to audition before our Selection Panel on-site in the week commencing Monday 10 March 2025 (following the Labour Day public holiday). We will contact families beforehand with a date and time for their child's audition.
- **Interview with the Principal:** We invite selected candidates to an interview with our Principal, Mr Matt Dodd. The invitation is based on a candidate's audition performance, and evidence of a minimum standard of AMEB Grade 4 (or equivalent) in their chosen instrument.

The Music Scholarship is awarded at the sole discretion of the Principal.
